

**Baptist e-Learning Modules (20%).** Students are required to complete the Baptist Health Intercultural Palliative Care e-Learning modules to pass the course. Students are encouraged to complete e-Learning modules prior to class, as it enhances their learning experience and increases their ability to contribute to group learning at each session.

While modules vary in content and duration depending on the number of lessons, each concludes with a multiple-choice quiz. A grade of 75% or higher is required on each quiz to pass each module. Only one attempt is allowed, and student grades for each module are recorded and averaged into a final score. Failure to complete the modules on time results in a deduction of points.

To access modules and tests:

- Go to **CMEOnline.BaptistHealth.net**.
- To access a CME course for the first time, click **Register** at the top right, and fill in the information on the **Create New Account** page.
- For subsequent login attempts, select **Log in** to access course modules.
- Go to the **Catalog tab and select Online Catalog**.
- Search for **Baptist Health Intercultural Palliative Care Training Program**.
- Click course title to open page.
- Select module.
- Click **Register** button to enter course.
- Click **Start Course**.

Faculty and staff verify student completion of all modules. However, students also are required to upload to CanvasMed a certificate of the completed course for each required session as proof that they have completed and passed the modules.

To download certificates:

- Select **My account** at the top right
- Select **My Activities**.
- Download certificates for completed modules.
